

Call for a Meeting to Endorse Candidates for James River Soil & Water Conservation Board

Adopted on December 17, 2018

I, Tara Carroll, Chairman of the Chesterfield County Republican Committee, pursuant to the Republican State Party Plan and as directed by the Chesterfield County Republican Committee do hereby issue this call for a meeting of its membership to be held on January 28, 2019 beginning at 7:00 PM at the Thomas Fulghum Conference Center (13900 Hull Street Rd., Midlothian, VA 23112) for the purpose of endorsing candidates for the James River Soil & Water Conservation Board from Chesterfield County for the General Election to be held on November 5, 2019.

Qualifications for Participation: All active, dues paying members of the Chesterfield County Republican Committee (CCRC), whose names appear on the official Membership Roster as of the adjournment of its December 2018 membership meeting, may participate.

Candidate Filing Requirements: Any person seeking endorsement by the Chesterfield County Republican Committee for the James River Soil & Water Conservation Board must be a legal and qualified voter under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia residing in the county of the office for which he or she seeks. He must file a written statement of his candidacy and interest in receiving the CCRC's Endorsement, to be received by Tara C. Carroll (1333 Astley Terrace, Midlothian, VA 23114) no later than 5:00 PM on January 21, 2019. Postmarks will not govern. The statement of candidacy must include: (1) a statement that the candidate is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party; and (2) and that the candidate pledges to support all of the Republican Party's nominees for office in the ensuing General Election. To be eligible to receive the CCRC endorsement, a candidate must file his "Declaration of Candidacy", and sufficient petition signatures to qualify for the ballot, with the General Registrar of Chesterfield County prior to the January 28, 2019 meeting. If requested, candidates will present evidence of that filing to the Chairman of the CCRC.

Conduct of the Endorsement Meeting:

Each active, dues paying member of the CCRC may cast his vote for a duly-filed candidate. Write-in votes will not be considered. The top two candidates receiving the most votes from the entirety of the votes cast by the full voting membership of the CCRC, will receive the endorsement. In the event only two eligible candidates for the James River Soil & Water Conservation Board seek the CCRC's Endorsement, said candidates will automatically receive the Endorsement and no vote will take place at the January 28, 2019 membership meeting.

Use of the Endorsement of the CCRC

All candidates who receive the endorsement of the CCRC may reference the endorsement of the Committee in their literature, advertising and other campaign materials.
