Qualifications for Participation

All citizens of the United States who are legal and qualified voters of Chesterfield County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Candidate Filing Requirements

Candidates for Chesterfield County Republican Committee Chairman and Executive Officers must declare their candidacy in writing, accompanied by the non-refundable filing fee of \$500 for Chairman or \$100 for Executive Officer, which must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 3, 2026. Postmarks shall not govern.

Candidates for Membership in the Chesterfield County Republican Committee must submit the official filing form (available at chesterfieldgop.com and virginia.gop), accompanied by annual dues of \$35, which must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 13, 2026. Postmarks shall not govern.

All declarations of candidacy, applications for membership, and respective filing fees and dues must be received by the Vice Chairman of Organization Leslie Matthews, [3301 West Grove Ave, Chester, VA 23831], by the applicable deadline.

Cancellation Provisions

If the number of persons filing as candidates for election does not exceed the number to be elected for a particular office, those persons shall be declared elected.

If the number of persons filing as candidates for election for all offices does not exceed the number to be elected, the Canvass will be cancelled.
