OFFICIAL BALLOT QUESTION

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to (i) protect the freedom to make personal decisions about prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, birth control, abortion, miscarriage management, and fertility care; (ii) protect doctors, nurses, and patients from being punished for these decisions; and (iii) allow for restrictions on access to abortion during the third trimester of pregnancy except when the patient's health is at risk or the pregnancy cannot survive?

WHAT IT ACTUALLY DOES & WHY VOTE NO

- Undermines parental rights by extending "fertility care" for "every individual" including minors, this includes sterilization and transgender procedures.
- Allows up to moment of birth abortions
- Babies born alive left to die by protecting abortionists from prosecution for not providing life-saving care.
- Allows unregulated sale and purchase of human embryos leading to the exploitation of women.
- Promotes Abortion Tourism.
- Removes ALL liability of ANYONE aiding/performing an abortion

OFFICIAL BALLOT QUESTION

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to (i) remove the ban on same-sex marriage; (ii) affirm that two adults may marry regardless of sex, gender, or race; and (iii) require all legally valid marriages to be treated equally under the law?

WHAT IT ACTUALLY DOES & WHY VOTE NO

- Hides the real agenda for trans ideology
- Embeds gender ideology in the Constitution by creating a distinction between "sex" and "gender".
- Allows males in female sports and spaces raising safety and privacy concerns
- No religious freedom protection for moral or ethical objections which threatens clergy, organizations, and businesses with litigation.
- Same-sex and heterosexual marriage are already legal and treated the same under the law and Supreme Court ruling.

OFFICIAL BALLOT QUESTION

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to (i) provide for the fundamental right to vote in the Commonwealth; (ii) to revise the qualifications of voters so that a person convicted of a felony is not entitled to vote during his period of incarceration but is automatically invested with the right to vote upon release from incarceration; and (iii) to update the existing prohibition on voting by persons found to be mentally incompetent to instead apply to persons who have been found to lack the capacity to understand the act of voting?

WHAT IT ACTUALLY DOES & WHY VOTE NO

- Establishes a right to vote for violent felons, as well as non-violent, because there is no distinction. This includes murderers, rapists, and pedophiles.
- Allows violent felons to also serve as jurors, judges, and elected or appointed representatives.
- Changes the rule on mental competency to apply only to those who lack the capacity to understand the act of voting. Who makes that determination?
